

The Compassionate Christ

Matthew 9:36

When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.

Matthew 14:14

"When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them and healed their sick."

Matthew 15:32

Jesus... said, "I have compassion for these people... I do not want to send them away hungry, or they may collapse on the way."

The Compassionate Christ

Matthew 20:34

Jesus had compassion on them and touched their eyes.

Luke 7:13 (NASB)

... He felt compassion for her, and said to her, "Do not weep."

Compassion

- σπλαγχνίζομαι (splagchnízomai)
- To be deeply affected in one's inner being (literally the bowels – the seat of emotions)
- To be moved with compassion, pity, deep empathy

We are to be compassionate like Christ!

EPHESIANS 4:32-5:1

Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you. Follow God's example, therefore, as dearly loved children and walk in the way of love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.





LUKE 13:12-13

¹² When **Jesus saw her, he called her** forward and said to her, "Woman, you are set free from your infirmity."

¹³ Then **he put his hands on her**, and immediately she straightened up and praised God.

Compassion is active in caring; not passive



Compassion prompts actions of care; it is more than just a feeling

¹¹ and a woman was there who had been **crippled by a spirit for eighteen years**...

¹² When Jesus saw her, he called her forward and said to her, "Woman, you are set free from your infirmity."
