4. What happens at Family Communion?

- · Wait for your whole group to arrive
- Once ALL group members are present, send one representative to the respective locations in the centers: Trinity Paya Lebar - Level 4, Chapel Trinity Adam - Level 2, Theatrette 2 Trinity Chao Chu Kang - Level 3, Sanctuary
- Your group will be assigned a prayer room
- · Proceed to the prayer room
- At the assigned prayer room:
 pray as a group
 partake communion
 - a pastor/minister will pray for you
- Exit the prayer room



Frequently Asked Questions

- 5. What if my group needs more time to share before the pastor prays for us? As there would be other groups waiting to be assigned a prayer room, consider pre-arranging a time outside of Family Communion for sharing.
- Are there other groups in the same prayer room?
 Yes. Do expect other groups to be assigned and be in the same prayer room concurrently.
- I am attending Family Communion in a group, how many people can there be in one group? There is no group size limit.

- I am coming alone. Can I still attend Family Communion? Of course. Do follow the same process described in Q4.
- 9. Can I take more than one communion?

Each person should take maximum two communion with your biological family and Connect Group to allow others to participate.
