Isaiah 41: 10, “I will strengthen you and help you.”

LESSON SUMMARY

Bible text: 1 Kings 17: 7 – 16

The children learnt that God provided food for Elijah because God cares for him. In the same way, the children learnt that God cares for them by providing for their needs.

FOR FAMILY ACTIVITY: LET'S PRETEND!

Plan a bread making session with your child. As he helps you make the dough, you can talk to your child about the lesson found in 1 Kings 17: 7-16. If that's not convenient, it can be a “Let's Pretend” session. Give your child some play dough and pretend to make bread then talk about the following:

1. Why did Elijah go to the woman's town? (*He was hungry*)
2. How did God help the woman? (*He gave her oil and flour until the rain came*)
3. Who gives us food and other things we need? (*God*)
4. This is why, every time before we eat our food, we give thanks to God. God cares for us, just as He cared for Elijah, the woman and her son.

Take time to thank God for His provision and taking care of your daily needs.
