LESSON: SAMUEL WORKS IN THE TEMPLE

POWER WORD

1 Kings 22:19, "Hear the Word of the Lord."

LESSON SUMMARY

Bible text: 1 Samuel 1:21-28; 2:11,18,26

The children learnt that Samuel helped in God's house. Samuel was a good helper in God's house. They also learnt that they can be helpers in God's house.

FOR FAMILY ACTIVITY: WE CAN HELP IN GOD'S HOUSE

Throughout the week, create opportunities for your child to help at home. Eg. Clean the table after a meal, clean his room, throw the rubbish, etc. Each time he helps, praise him for being a good helper. You can talk about how Samuel helped in God's house too and then ask him the following questions:

- Who was Eli's helper? (*Samuel*)
- How did Samuel help in God's house? (*swept the floor, cleaned the lamps, lit the lamps*)
- How can you help at church? (*Allow your child to respond. Affirm him as he expresses different ways to help in God's house – eg. Keep the church clean, keep the toys after playing, throw the rubbish into the bin, etc.*)

Thank God that you can all serve in God's house. Pray that as a family, you will all be faithful in serving God.
