




- The act of offering something as a means of atonement, worship, or thanksgiving

 The New Testament applies the Old Testament concept of sacrifice to Christ


- "so Christ was sacrificed once to take away the sins of many; and he will appear a second time, not to bear sin, but to bring salvation to those who are waiting for him."
 - Hebrews 9:28











