Old Testament

- The act of offering something as a means of atonement, worship or thanksgiving
- The offering may involve slaughtering an animal or making an offering of grain or another agricultural product
- Leviticus 1-7



SACRIFICE

New Testament

- Applies the Old Testament concept of sacrifice to Christ
- Jesus is the perfect sacrifice
- Hebrews 9:28

and being born in the likeness of men.

He humbled Himself
by becoming obedient to the point of death:
