

 - To receive requires an active posture of not just waiting but a hunger and expectation

Receiving the baptism in the Holy Spirit is a promise and certainty that is fulfilled by our active posture of hunger and expectation





 - Convicted and compelled

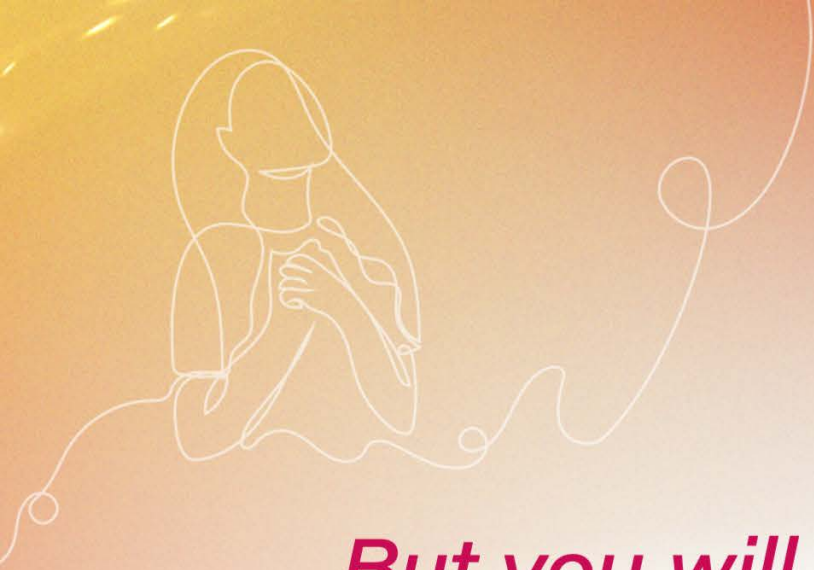
As witnesses of the gospel, we have experienced the reality of the message and are empowered by the power of the Holy Spirit.
