

Genesis 37:1-28


- Jacob favored Joseph more than all his other sons

- A merchant's caravan came, and the brothers sold him to Egypt








- The beginning of all sin (Genesis)










Genesis 39:19-23

Genesis 40:23 The chief cupbearer, however, did not remember Joseph; he forgot him.











- What are things within your control that you can work on?
