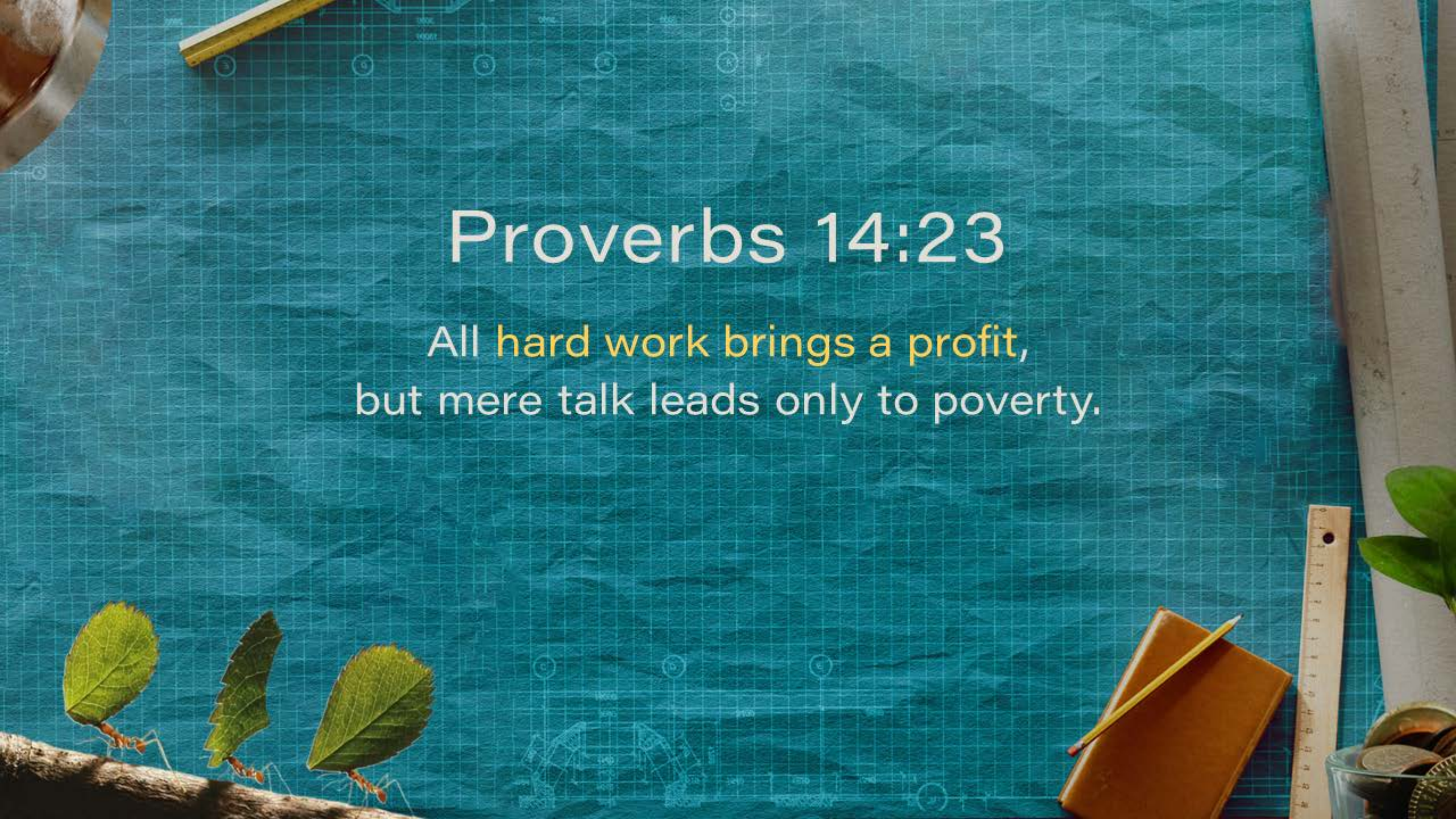
Principle of *Diligence*

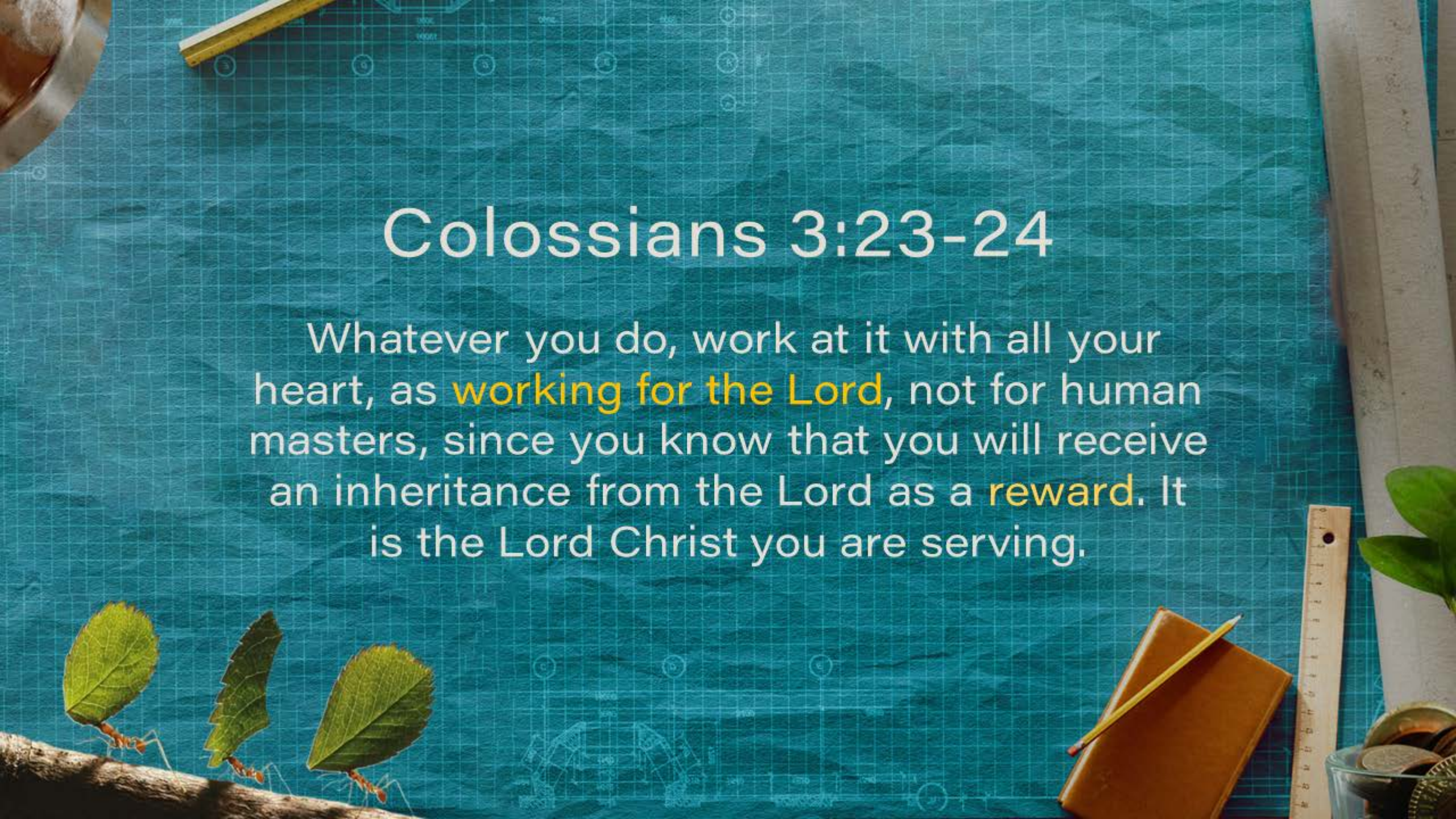
Proverbs 14:23

Principle of *Impartation*


2 Timothy 3:1-4
