THE PROPHETIC DISTINCTION

1 KINGS 17:1-6



Prophetic

Hearing the voice of God and knowing the heart of God, walking in obedience and releasing God's will to our world and generation

Distinction

A difference or contrast between similar things or people; being set apart

- Elijah means Yahweh is my God
- God calls Elijah and sets him apart as a prophet

Prophetic distinction is the call of God that sets us apart as His people and for His purpose


- Contrast with 1 Kings 16:29-34 where Ahab who was God's appointed king but led the nation astray by worshipping Baal

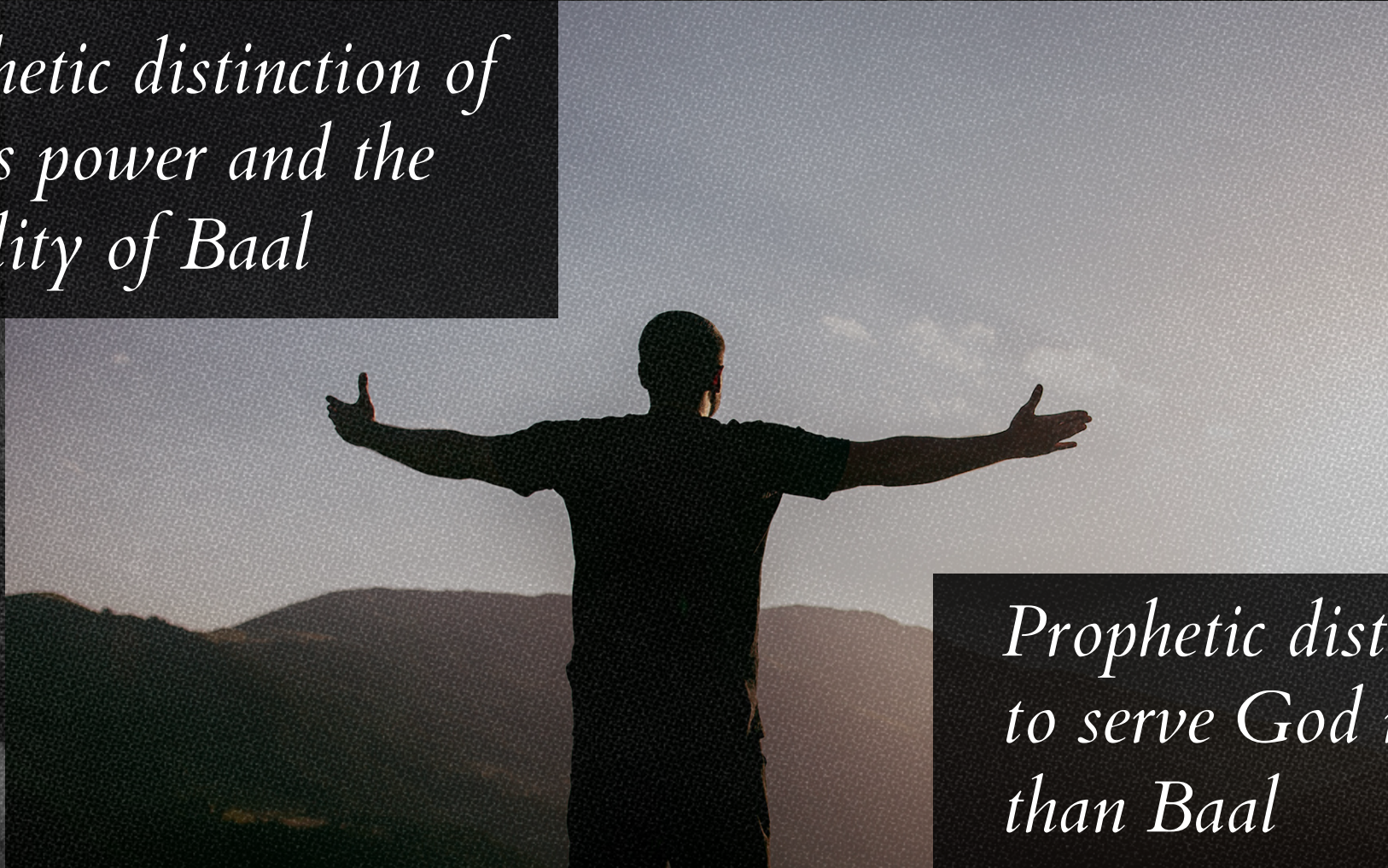
