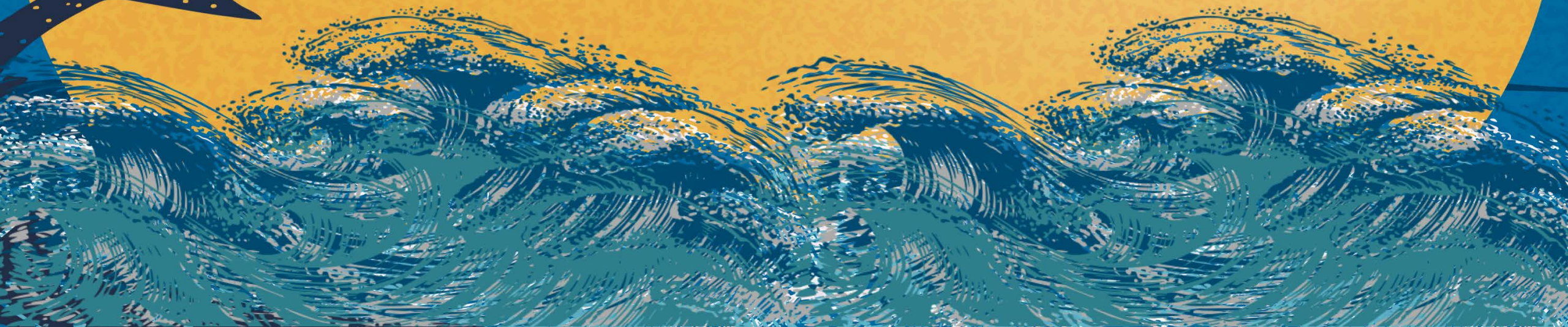

JONAH 2:1-4 NASB



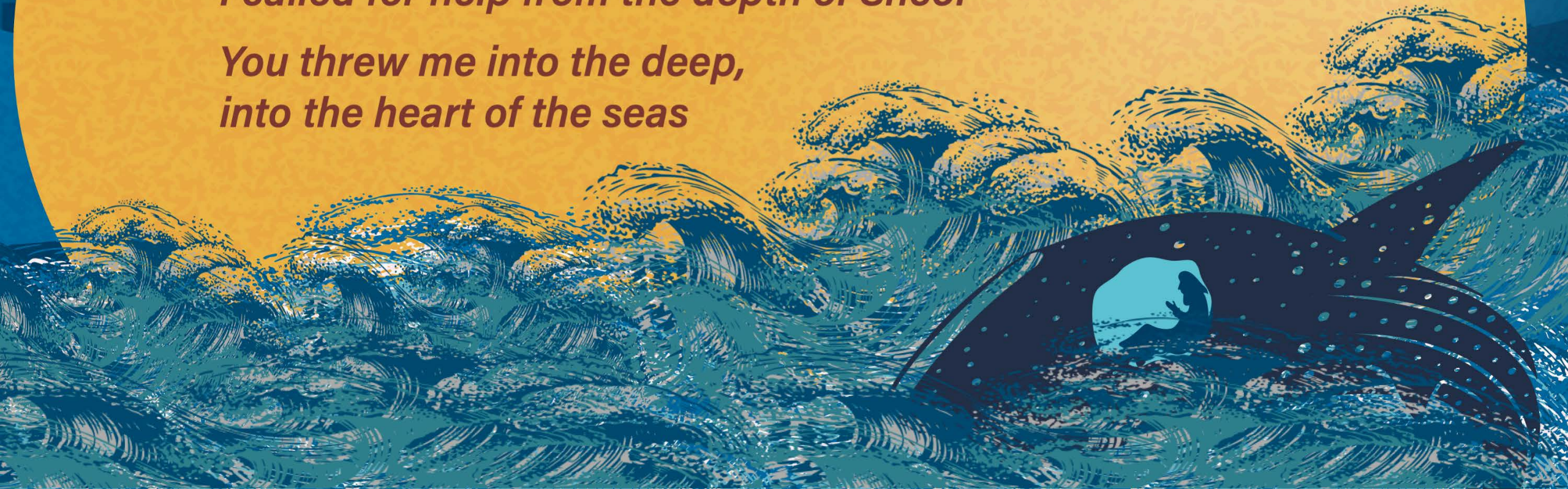
THE CRY FOR MERCY

THE CRY FOR REPRIEVE



MEANING OF REPRIEVE

An official order that stops or delays the punishment, especially by death, of a prisoner

An escape from a bad situation or experience

*We must be convicted to pray
for people to know God regardless how
many times they have rejected Him*



THE CRY FOR REPRIEVE

*God gives us second chances
to share the gospel because
He desires our participation*

THE CRY OF REPENTANCE



MEANING OF REPENTANCE

To turn away from evil and return to God

To repent and to convert involved obedience to God's revealed will, placing trust in him, turning away from all evil and ungodliness

to rend hearts and convict
people to repent and be saved*
