














"You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly... But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us."









THE WAYS OF MAN

Use of palm leaves, laying of cloaks on the ground, shouts – of Hosanna, meaning "Save us now!"

Crowds went out to meet a triumphant victor, a national liberator into town

Hoping to be freed from Roman rule; political victory

THE WAYS OF GOD

Jesus entered Jerusalem sitting on a young donkey – a simple, everyday animal used by common people

Fulfilling prophecy, the triumphant King is righteous, gentle, and humble ZECHARIAH 9:9-10

Victory over sin, death, and the enemy; bringing peace, freedom, and life
