- The Holy Spirit is a Person




ROLES OF THE HOLY SPIRIT IN OUR LIVES

Acts 2:42 NIV


Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts...

Acts 2:46 NIV

Same meaning which is to be earnestly towards, persevere, constantly diligent

The disciples continued to hunger for the Holy Spirit as they gathered together to seek God even after being baptized with the Holy Spirit

They did not stop being hungry!



We need to gather together to seek God with a hunger and desire for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit in our lives



They all joined together constantly in *prayer*...

Acts 1:14 NIV

They devoted themselves... to prayer.

Acts 2:42 NIV

There is a demonstration of *intention* in praying together

When they heard this, they raised their voices together in prayer to God...

Acts 4:24 NIV

So Peter was kept in prison, but *the church was earnestly praying* to God for him.

Acts 12:5 NIV

When this had dawned on him, he went to the house of Mary the mother of John, also called Mark, where *many people had gathered and were praying*.

Acts 12:12 NIV

There is a demonstration of *intensity* in praying together

After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly.

Acts 4:31 NIV

Then Peter came to himself and said, "Now I know without a doubt that the Lord has sent his angel and rescued me...

Acts 12:11 NIV

There is a demonstration of intervention by the Holy Spirit
