

TRUTHS ABOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT

- The Holy Spirit is God – he is part of the Triune God
- The Holy Spirit is a Person





ROLES OF THE HOLY SPIRIT IN OUR LIVES

- He is our Helper
- He teaches and reminds us of Jesus' teachings
- He convicts us of our sins and draws us to Jesus
- He reveals and guides us into truth

When the day of Pentecost came,
they were all together in one place.

Acts 2:1 NIV

The disciples gathered together to earnestly and continuously seek God and wait for the Holy Spirit

They **devoted** themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.

Acts 2:42 NIV


Every day they **continued to meet together** in the temple courts...

Acts 2:46 NIV

Same meaning which is to be earnestly towards, persevere, constantly diligent

The disciples continued to hunger
for the Holy Spirit as they gathered
together to seek God even after
being baptized with the Holy Spirit

*They did not stop
being hungry!*

They all joined together constantly in ***prayer***...

Acts 1:14 NIV

They devoted themselves... ***to prayer***.

Acts 2:42 NIV

There is a demonstration of ***intention*** in praying together

When they heard this,
***they raised their voices
together in prayer*** to God...

Acts 4:24 NIV

So Peter was kept in prison,
but ***the church was earnestly
praying*** to God for him.

Acts 12:5 NIV

When this had dawned on him, he went to the house of Mary
the mother of John, also called Mark, where ***many people
had gathered and were praying.***
