And by that will, we have been made holy through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.









# STAY HOLY

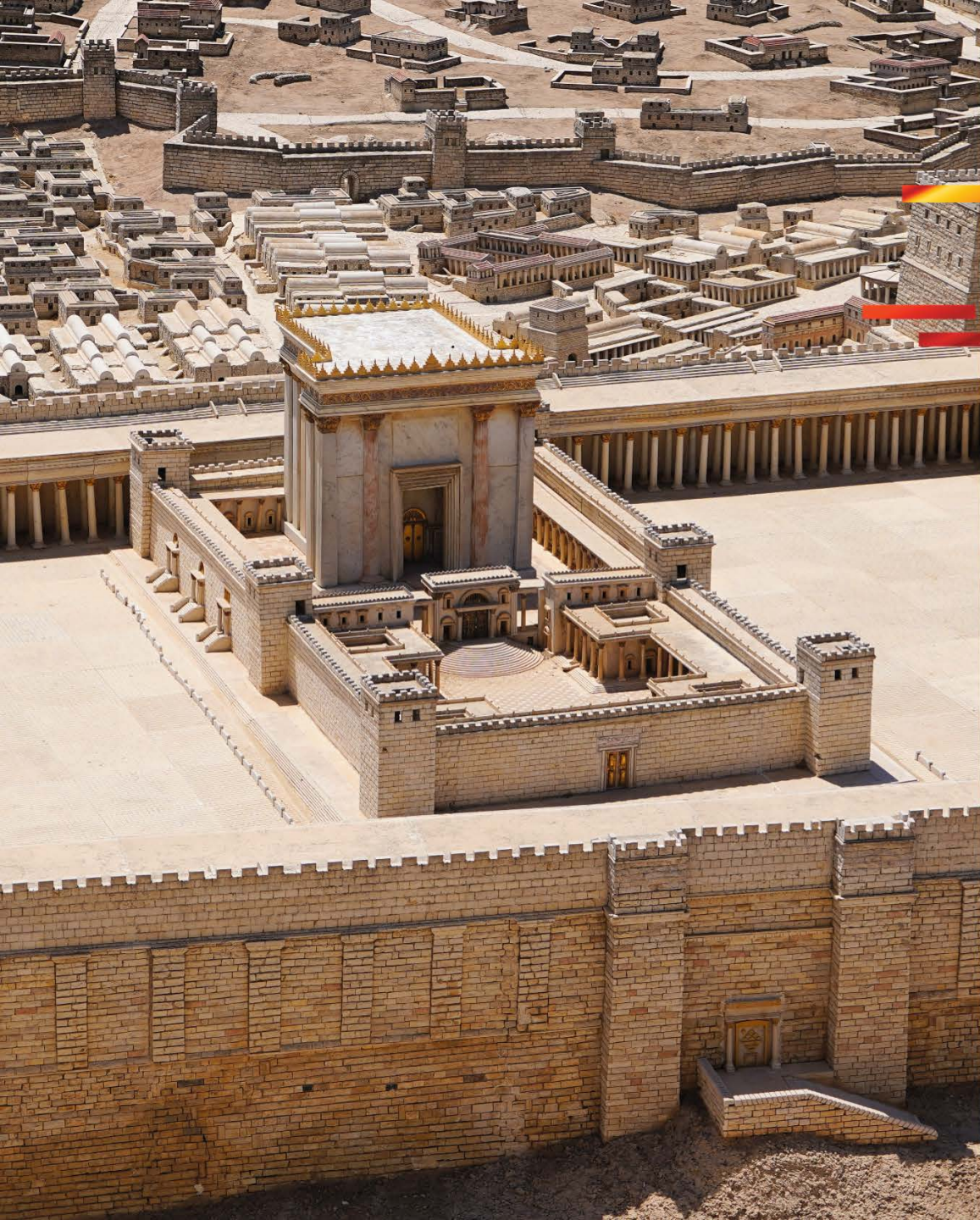
# STAY HOLY

# OLD TESTAMENT TEMPLE

- Holy of Holies represented God's manifest Presence





# NEW TESTAMENT





We are the temple of the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 3:16-17)





## *1 Corinthians 3:16–17* NASB

Do you not know that you are a temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? If anyone destroys the temple of God, God will destroy that person; for the temple of God is holy, and that is what you are.

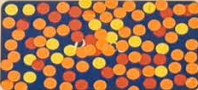

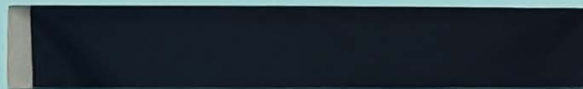

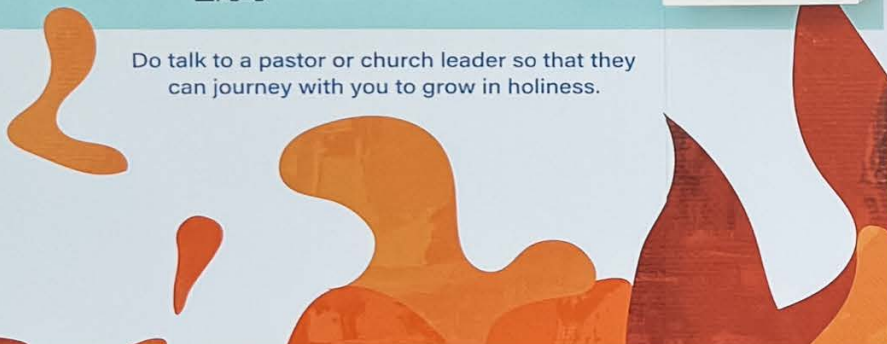

*2 Timothy 2:20-21*










## *2 Timothy 2:20–21* NIV

In a large house there are articles not only of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay; some are for special purposes and some for common use. for His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to life and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence.






We have the power of God to serve Him
