Acts 3:7-8 NIV


For the man who was miraculously healed was **over forty years old**.



In the months leading up to 1904, Welsh evangelist Seth Joshua prayed earnestly that God would raise a young working-class man to awaken the churches. At the same time, Evan Roberts, a coal miner in his late teens, was simed by a deep longing for more of God.

Though devoted to the Word, he became restless, waking at 1am to pray for hours, crying out for revival in Wales.

In September 1904, at one of Joshua's meetings, Roberts responded to God's call. The following month, 16 young people attended his first meeting in his home church and were deeply moved.
