














 At daybreak they entered the temple courts, as they had been told, and began to teach the people v21

• Our obedience under pressure is seen in our courage to act




• The Holy Spirit empowers us to be courageous and not cower under pressure








- Peter received a vision where God told him to eat animals that were impure v11-15

ADVANCEMENT OF GOD'S KINGDOM

- 3000 people were saved through Peter's preaching
- Healing of the lame beggar and preaching to the crowd resulting in 2000 people saved ACTS 3 TO ACTS 4:4
- Healing of Aeneas ACTS 9:32-35
- Holy Spirit came upon the Gentiles and they were water baptized ACTS 10:44-48
