


- Daniel 6:4-9



God's approval or human applause?




What “kings” are you pressured into bowing to?

- Is my schedule too full of striving to leave room for surrender?






What will you do?

Compromising would

- Weaken Daniel's character and witness
- Erode Daniel's relationship with God
- Grant fear and comfort more power than faith in God

- If my faith became illegal tomorrow, would there be enough evidence to convict me?
- Do I obey God only when it's convenient, or also when it's costly?


- Focus on **WHO** is with you than what surrounds you
