

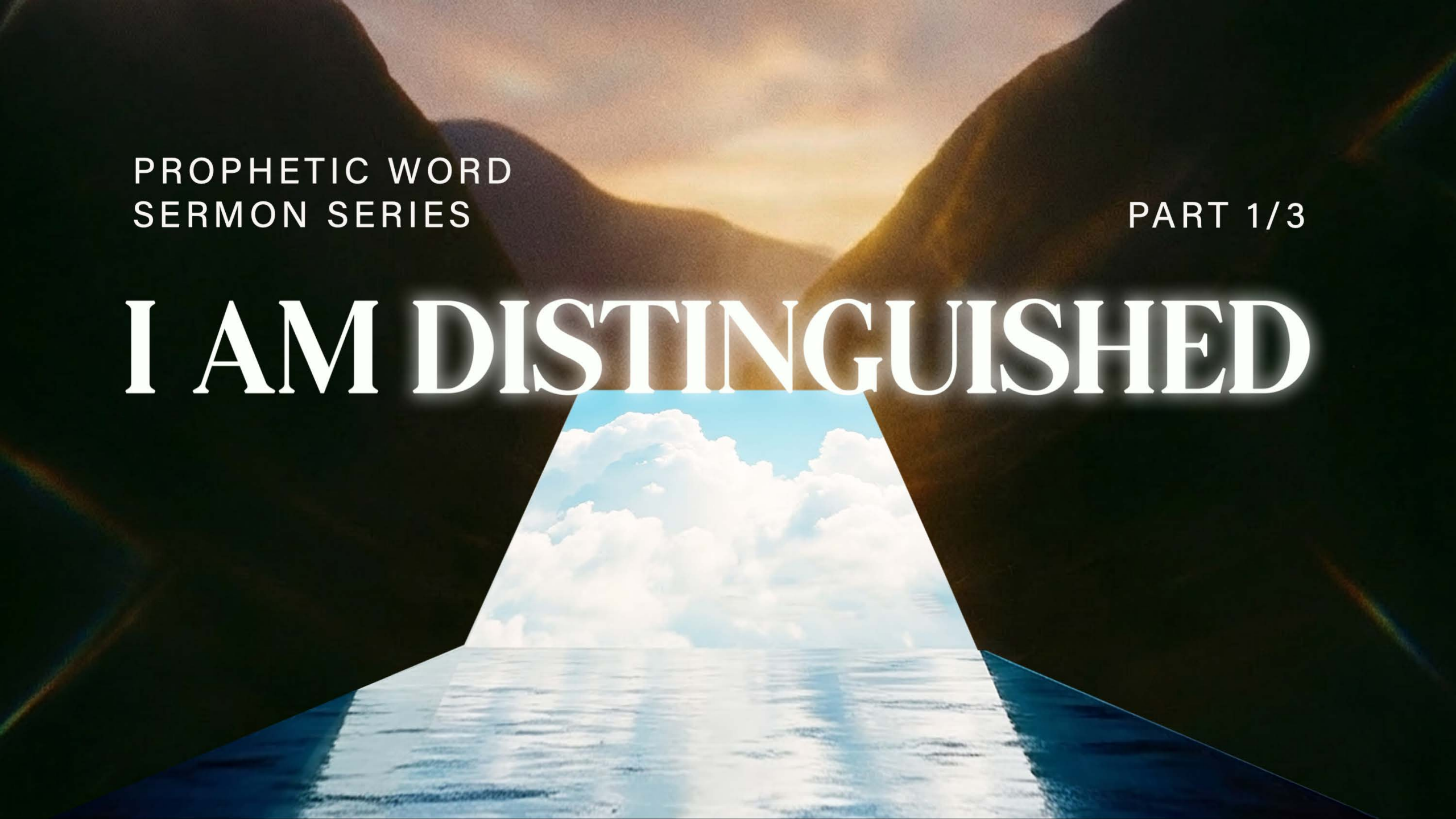

ABSOLUTE TRUST in God







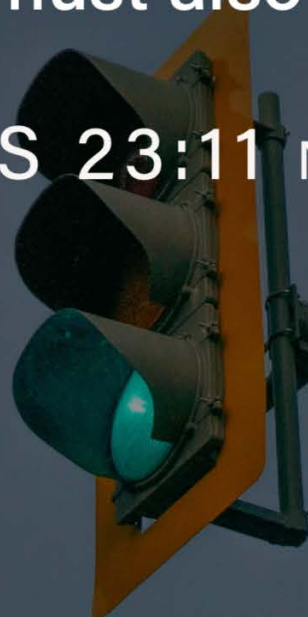
