v5 - Master > **v8** - Lord

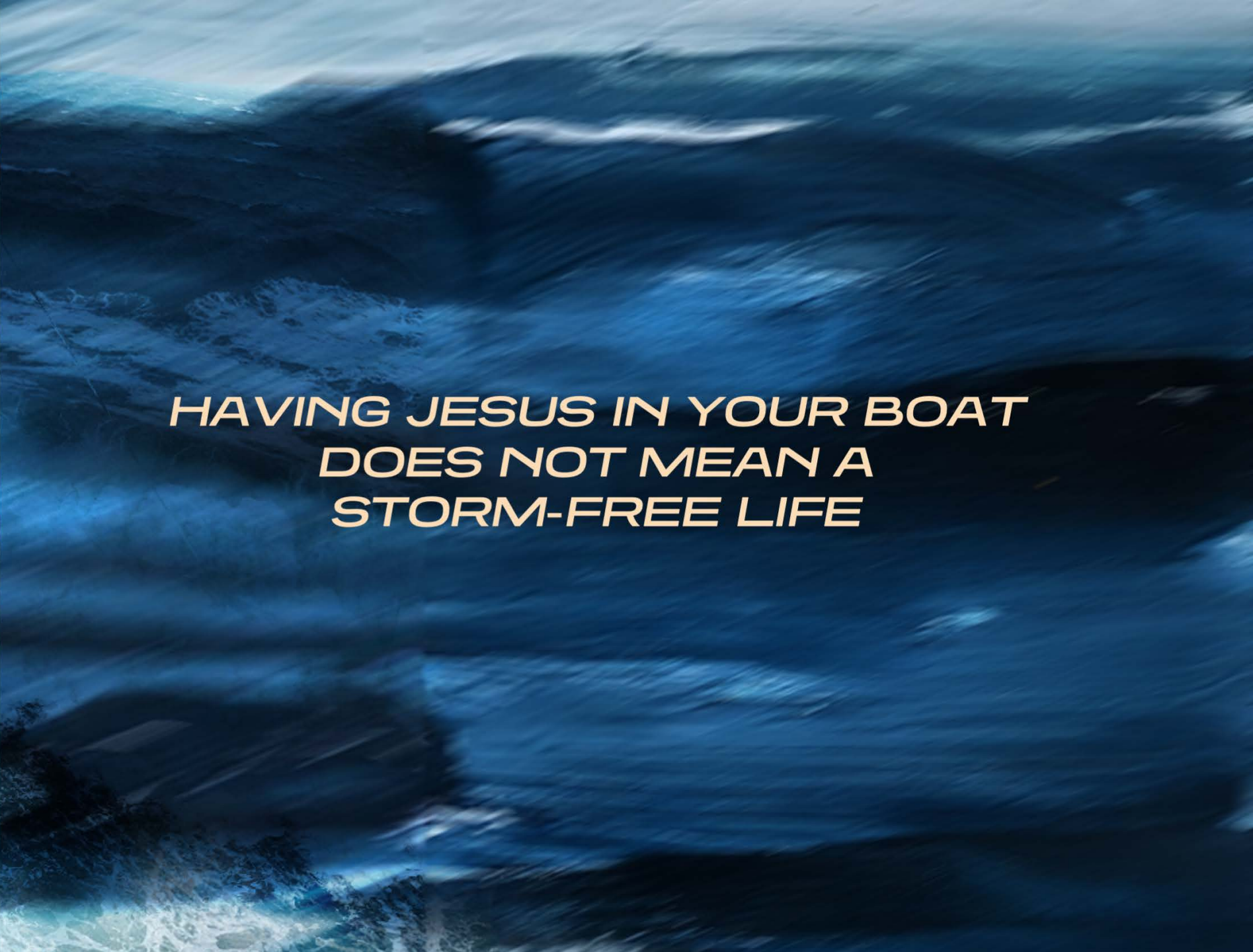
v11 - left everything and followed Him

- Lordship of Jesus

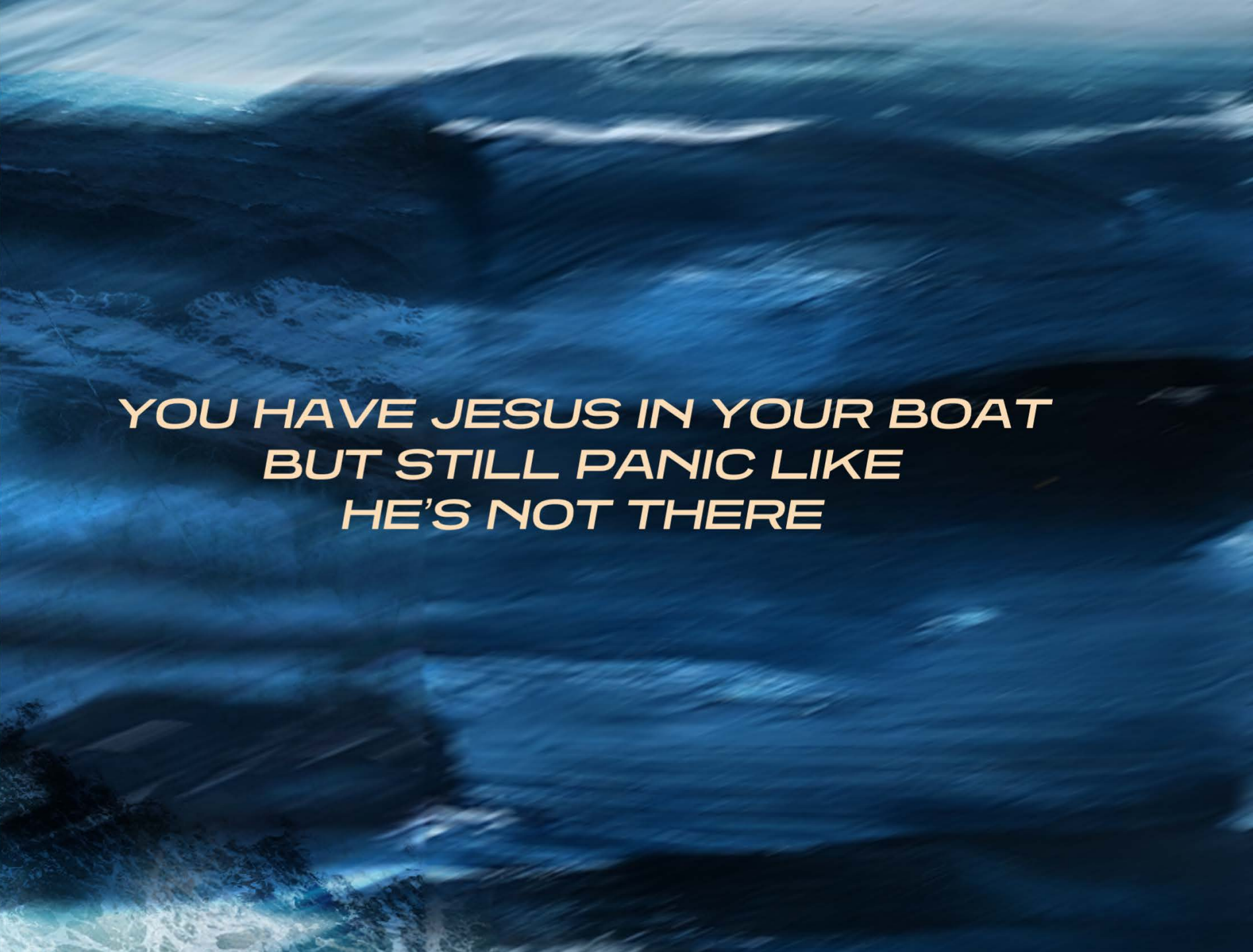


LUKE 8:22-25

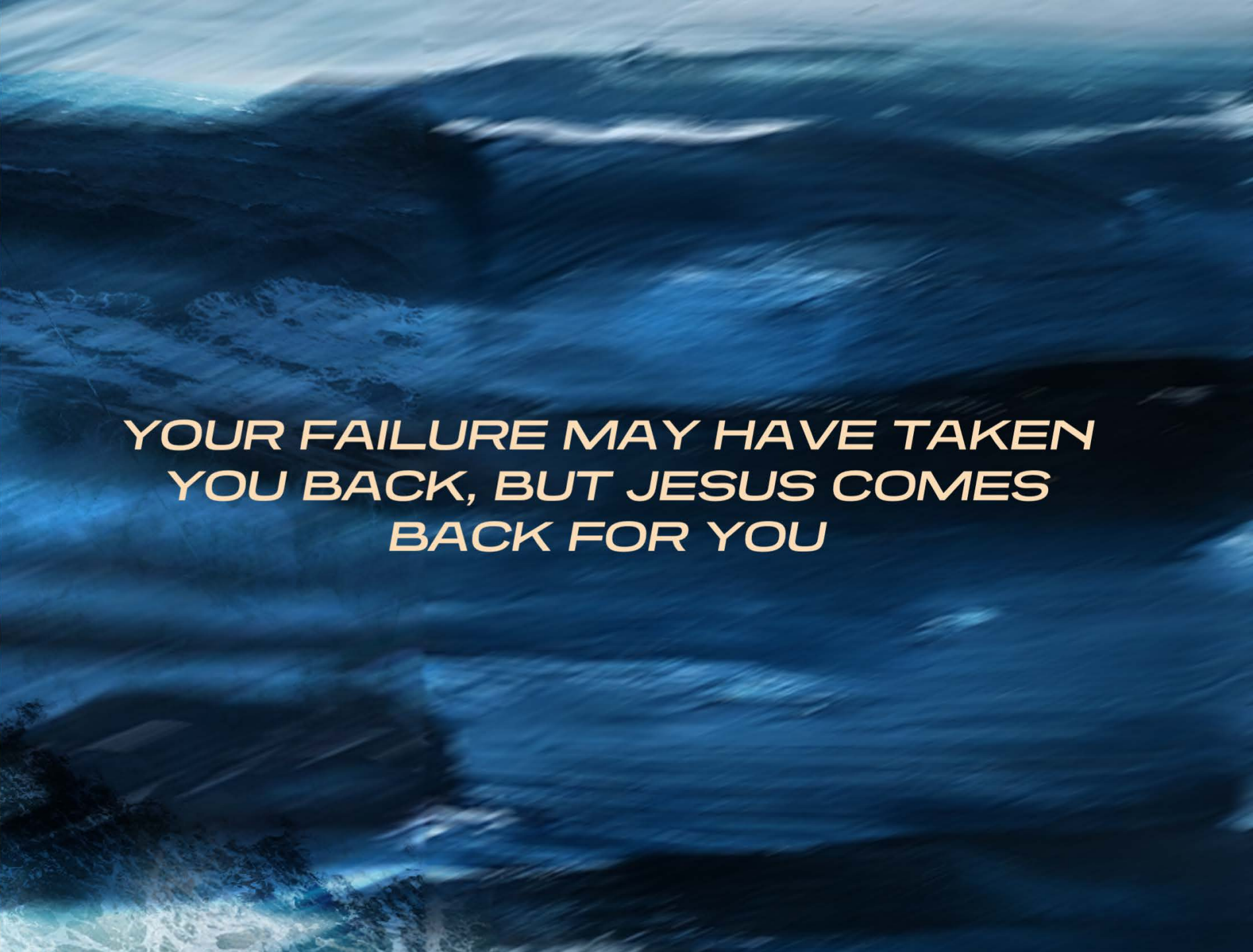

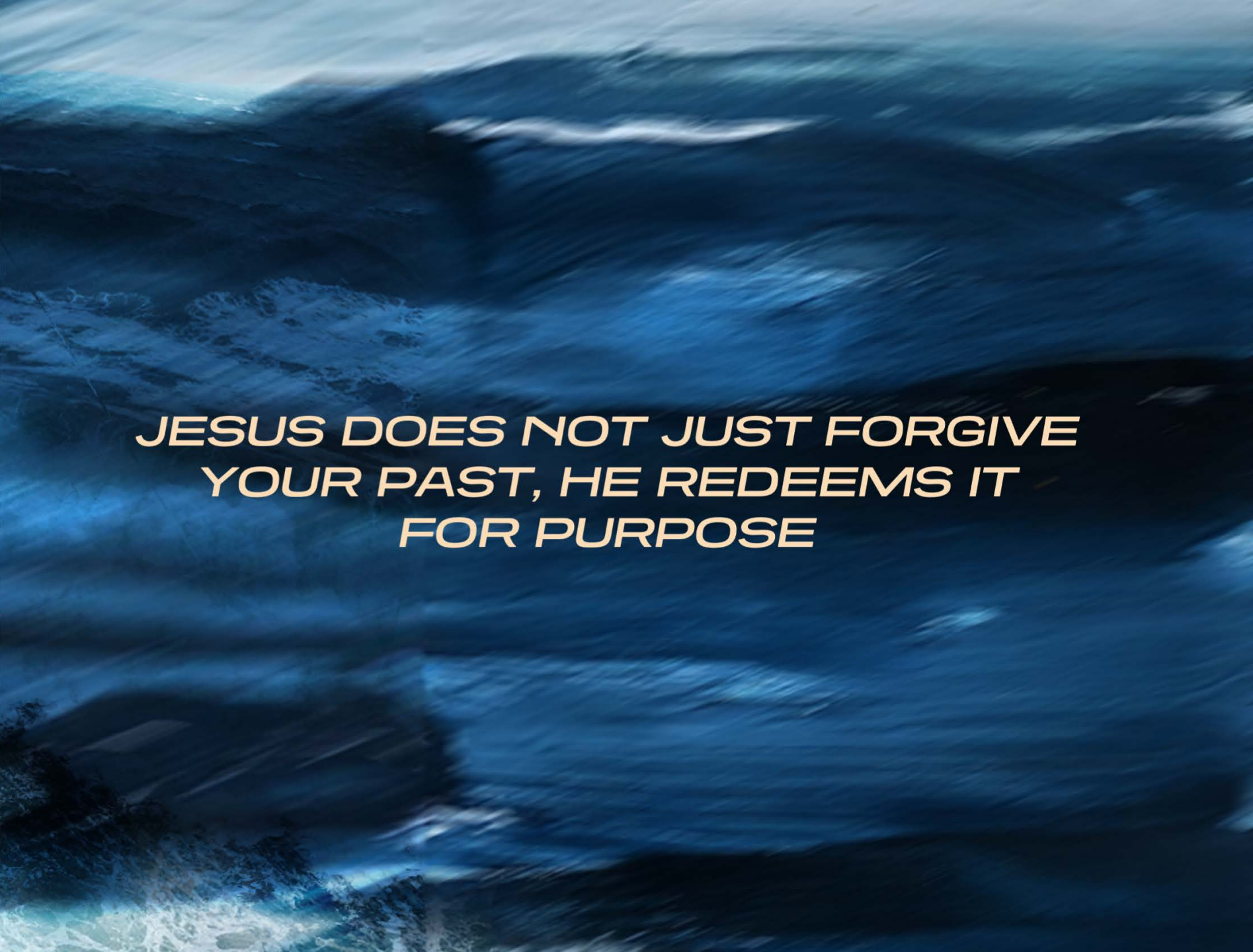
Peter went back to fishing
