- Continuous commitment – unrestricted by time or location
- Whole-person commitment
  - body, mind, heart, spirit (behavior, actions, thinking, emotions)

soul, mind, and strength. It is our wholehearted love

# LIVING STONES — NOT INANIMATE / PASSIVE

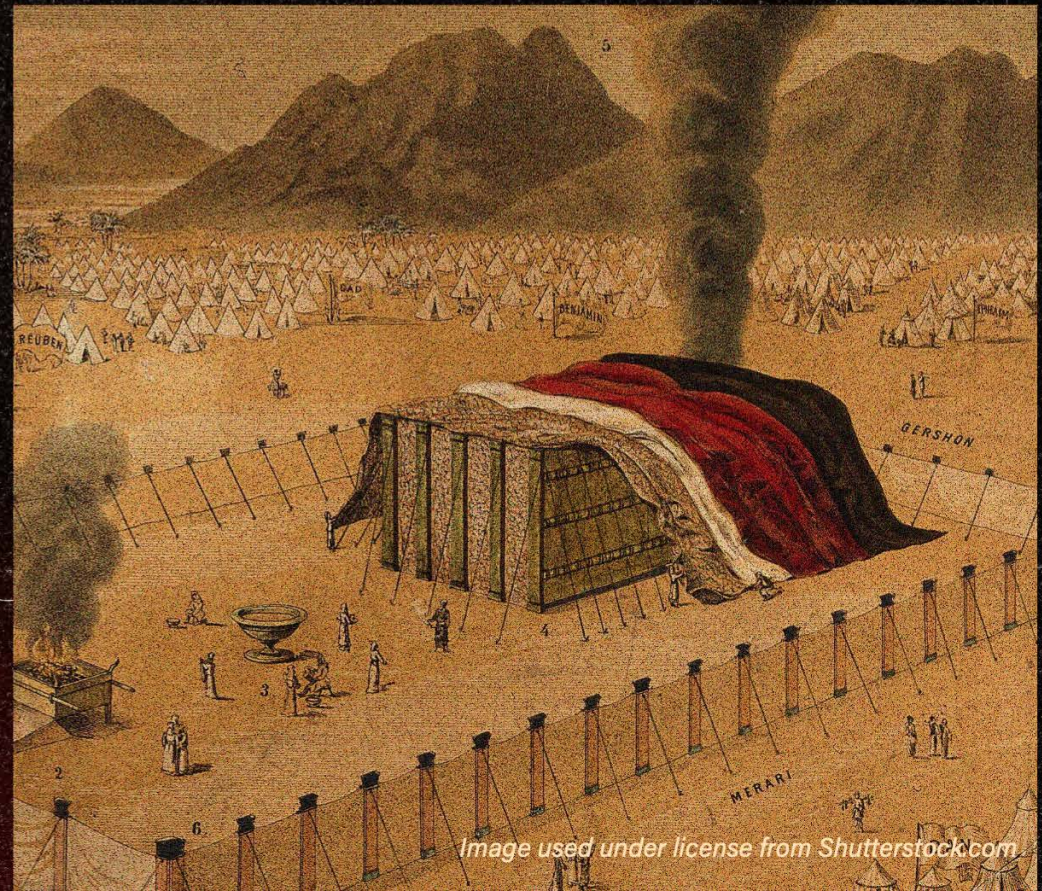


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# LIVING STONES — NOT INANIMATE / PASSIVE

- Built together, we offer sacrifices (in worship) to the Lord
- Connected together, we are a spiritual house where God dwells

*Our life as a worship to God also means **together,**  
**as living stones – as a corporate body of Christ** – we  
offer our sacrifice of worship to God.*

*It involves our corporate worship time of singing and  
praising God together. It also means all of us actively  
involved in serving Him together – building God's house –  
where He dwells.*

# LIVING STREAMS OF WATER FLOWING FROM WITHIN
